YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL CHECKLIST:

- 1) You may use the turnabout from 7:30 to 8:30am, from 9:30 to 11 am, from 1:30 to 6 pm, M – F.
- 2) **TOY DAY IS FRIDAY ONLY**
We do not allow toy weapons at Haygood.
- 3) Please replace your child's seasonal emergency clothes at school. Bring a sweater, socks, long sleeved shirts . . .
- 4) Please mark all your child's belongings with first and last names
- 5) **Crocs AND soled, strapped shoes:**
Crocs are dangerous on the playground. They are too loose and the soles are not strong enough against the wood chips. Often – since summer 07 - children and adults have slipped, tripped or fallen or wood chips have cut through the Croc bottoms and injured children's and adult's feet. If you bring Crocs . . . please bring hard-sole, strapped shoes too! Thank you.
