### **In Closing Theresa Says...**

Last Spring, many of you responded to our Haygood CDC/HUT or Haygood Preschool Parent Survey. Thank you for taking the time to give us your feedback.

Haygood Weekday Children's Ministries Preschool and CDC have been using the survey as a tool for many years to help make decisions. In the past we have used this feedback to re-write policy, add staff, and make changes in how we communicate, or make you aware of why we do certain things the way we do. I would appreciate your participation in the survey this year.

The survey is a helpful tool that gives Kerry, Terrylynn and me insight into how well the parent community feels we are performing our jobs in delivering a quality program as we live out our mission. Our mission is printed in the front of your "Directory and Handbook" and it states: "Haygood Preschool/CDC is designed to assist children in many areas of development, including mental, emotional, social, and physical growth. We believe that each person is a child of God and deserving of love, acceptance, and support. We share our faith with children as we help them see themselves as persons of worth."

The CDC survey was administered on-line through Survey Monkey in 2008 and 2009, and the Preschool survey was available on-line in 2009. Last year, 63 people responded to the CDC survey, and 57 people responded to the Preschool survey. On a scale of 1 (not at all satisfied) to 5 (extremely satisfied), last years survey results showed a satisfaction rating with your child's class overall of 4.2 - 4.82 in the CDC, and 4.33 – 5.0 in the Preschool. Besides individual ratings for each classroom, we also ask you to rate your overall satisfaction with the oversight and administration of the programs. Last year the CDC rate was 4.57 and the Preschool rate was 4.83. The survey also allows for you to share "one thing you love..." and "name one thing that you wish you could change".

We have 202 families enrolled in the CDC and Preschool. My goal is for 100% of our families to be represented in the results. The survey is quick and easy to complete. The responses are reviewed by the CDC and Preschool Directors, discussed with and among the teachers, and shared with the WCM Board of Directors.

In an effort to receive the results of the Parent surveys earlier in the current academic year, we are planning to send the survey out to you during the month of February. We will be sending the survey to the same e-mail address where we send our e-mail reminders. If your e-mail address has changed please inform Kerry or Terrylynn. If you have supplied us with your current e-mail address and you are not getting our e-mail reminders, please check to see if your home or office computer has a spam filter that is blocking these reminders.
